I'm Telling You, Jesus Really IS Alive.

1 Corinthians 15:5-7

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

Main Idea: Jesus is alive, body and all.

Prefatory Remarks:

- 1.) Paul in this passage is preparing to address the false and destructive denial of the resurrection from the dead (v3-4).
- 2.) Our text tonight does not naturally lend itself to a nice three point sermon
- 3.) I want to encourage us to meditate on these truths as we prepare to celebrate the preeminent Christian holiday.

1.) The "What" (v5-7)

- A.) Jesus Appeared
- B.) He Appeared to Cephas
 - "...got up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found gathered together the eleven and those who were with them, 34 saying, "The Lord has really risen and has appeared to Simon."

Luke 24:33-34

- i.) this is obviously one of Christ's first appearances.
- ii.) Peter's last encounter with Christ was his Denial
- C.) He Appeared to the 12.

"While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be to you." 37 But they were startled and frightened and thought that they were seeing a spirit. 38 And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? 39 See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have." 40 And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet. 41 While they still could not believe it because of their joy and amazement, He said to

them, "Have you anything here to eat?" 42 They gave Him a piece of a broiled fish; 43 and He took it and ate it before them."
