## **Christ, the First fruits**

1 Corinthians 15:20-22

Main Idea: Being in Adam is the problem, being in Christ is the solution.

But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep.

1 Corinthians 15:20

## 1.) Christ is the first fruits of a much greater harvest.

- A.) Christ, as our first fruit, speaks to the quality and nature of the rest of the harvest.
- B.) The certainty of the rest of the harvest lies in our unity with Christ

But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.
