Two Common Misconceptions on Waiting for God's Son:

1.) The <u>Fight</u> Method of Waiting-Jesus is waiting for <u>us</u> to establish an earthly kingdom, <u>before</u> He returns.

Christendom- A period of history when the pope and a divinely-appointed king jointly ruled over a specific region.

I will now discover unto them a Country whose endowments are by learned men allowed to stand in a parallel with the Israelites Canaan - Thomas Morton

America would be the new Jerusalem.- William Tress

New England was to be a city on a hill that all the nations would look to and see the glory of God displayed before them.- John Winthrop

2.) The <u>Flight</u> Method of Waiting- <u>We</u> are Waiting for Jesus to Establish an Earthly Kingdom, <u>when</u> He returns.

The Biblical Conception of Waiting for God's Son:

- 3.) The <u>Fruitful Friction</u> Method of Waiting- We are Waiting in the <u>Already</u> and Waiting for the Not Yet.
 - A.) Christ Kingdom Has Already Been Inaugurated

The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand... (Mark 1:15)

Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, The kingdom of God does not come with observation; **21** nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you. (Luke 17:20-21)

...seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, **21** far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. **22** And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, (Ephesians 1:20-22)

B.) Christ's Kingdom Has Not Yet Been Consummated

Application:

Two Dangers Attached to the Two Misconceptions:

- 1.) There is a Danger in <u>Believing</u> We Can <u>Transform</u> the Kingdom of this World into the Kingdom of Christ.
- 2.) There is a Danger of <u>Thinking</u> We Can <u>Hide</u> From the World Because Christ Will Come Any Day.

The Biblical Way to Wait For God's Son:

- 3.) We Live As Citizens of Two Kingdoms
- **5** Build houses and dwell in them; plant gardens and eat their fruit. **6** Take wives and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons and give your daughters to husbands, so that they may bear sons and daughters—that you may be increased there, and not diminished. **7** And seek the peace of the city where I have caused you to be carried away captive, and pray to the Lord for it; for in its peace you will have peace.
