Deuteronomy 18:17, "And the Lord said to me: 'What they have spoken is good."

Deuteronomy 18:18, "I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren..."

3.) The Promise of a New House Implies a New Covenant

2 Samuel 7:27, "For You, O Lord of hosts, God of Israel, have revealed this to Your servant, saying, 'I will build you a house..."

1 Samuel 2:35, "Then I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest who shall do according to what is in My heart and in My mind. I will build him a sure house, and he shall walk before My anointed forever."

4.) The Structure of the Promise Implies a New Covenant

2 Samuel 7:14, "I will be his Father, and he shall be My son..."

Jeremiah 31:31-33, "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— **32** not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. **33** But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people."

5.) The Immediate Context in 2 Samuel Reminds Us of the <u>Fault</u> of the First Covenant
