9. God Offers the Free Gift of Salvation to Those Who _____ and ____ in Jesus (Romans 6:23; John 3:16-17; Acts 4:12; Ephesians 2:8-9).

*The gospel is good news that demands a response. We have only two options:

- **1:** _____ **in our sin and rebellion.** Those who respond this way will face God's judgment and wrath. (John 3:36; 2 Corinthians 4:3-6)
- **2:** _____ **to Christ as King by repentance and faith** (Mark 1:15, Romans 10:9-10). Those who respond this way will receive forgiveness and eternal life.
 - Picture: The parable of the treasure in the field (Matthew 13:44).
 - The Treasure = _____!
 - Only those that respond in saving faith gain entrance into the Kingdom.
 - What is Saving Faith?
 - Repent: To turn _____ of our sin and rebellion against God (and turn ____ God -Acts 20:20-21)

- We abandon everything with joy in order to have the field because the treasure is worth much more.
- Faith / trust: place our faith and hope in who Jesus is and what He has done. Faith is believing that the treasure, not this world that we leave behind, will satisfy forever.
 - Faith (πίστις) and Trust (πιστεύω) are simply different forms of the same greek word!
- Repentance and faith are not good works in themselves. They are acts of trust, in response to the good news of God's victory on our behalf. The Scriptures teach that salvation is not earned by good works but received by grace through faith in Christ (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- This is the Gospel that gives new life and salvation. But, it isn't just the way to God; it is the way of God.

10. Those Who Trust in Jesus Will Live to _____ Him and Will Receive the _____ of Eternal Life—_____ God Forever in Heaven.

- Each and every day we live by the power of the Gospel.
- In Christ, we have _____ to the power of sin, but been made _____ to a new, God-centered life (John 11:25; Romans 6:5-11; Galatians 2:20)
- The Holy Spirit _____ in us, daily conforming us to Christ's image and empowering us to obey God's commands by faith (Philippians 2:12-13; 1 John 2:15; Luke 9:23)
- We ______ all circumstances because Christ is ______ for us (Philippians 4:10-14 Philippians 1:20-21).
- Death is gain for the Christian because death has no ______ in Christ, and because He's more ______ to our souls than everything we lose in death. (1 Corinthians 15:54-58)
- Therefore, having been reconciled to God and adopted by Him, we get to be His people, in His place, under His kind rule forever (John 17:3; Psalm 16:11).
