- C.) David is <u>Unjustly</u> Judged <u>Justly</u>
- D.) The God Ordained Fulfillment of 2 Samuel 12:11-12

"...and I will take your wives before your eyes and give them to your neighbor, and he shall lie with your wives in the sight of this sun. **I2** For you did it secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel, before the sun.' — 2 Samuel 12:11-12

"...and Absalom went in to his father's concubines in the sight of all Israel." —2 Samuel 16:22

2.) Absalom's Ascent Is Both Physical and Spiritual

- A.) Absalom is the Consummate King of the Nations.
 - 2 Samuel 15:1— "...Absalom provided himself with chariots and horses, and fifty men to run before him."
- B.) Absalom is <u>Self-Appointed</u>, not the Lord's <u>Anointed</u>
- C.) Ahithophel is the consummate worldly wise man

"...For the Lord had purposed to defeat the good advice of Ahithophel..." —2 Samuel 17:14

"Therefore I advise that all Israel be fully gathered to you...and that you go to battle in person." —2 Samuel 17:11

"For the Lord had purposed to defeat the good advice of Ahithophel, to the intent that the Lord might bring disaster on Absalom." —2 Samuel 17:14

B.) The Path of Humble Repentance Leads to <u>Life</u>
