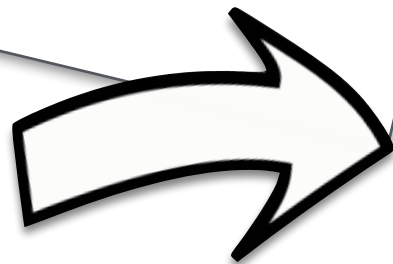

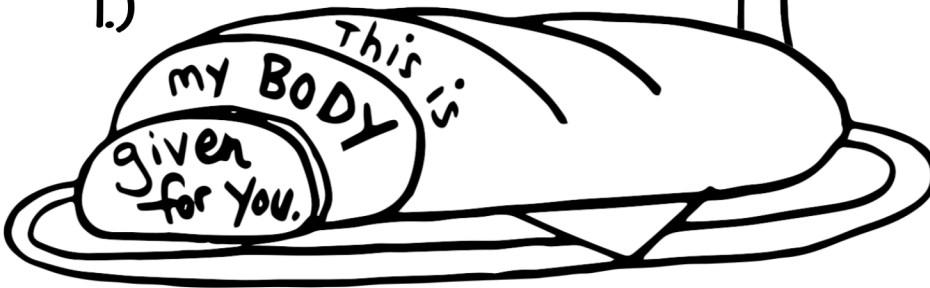

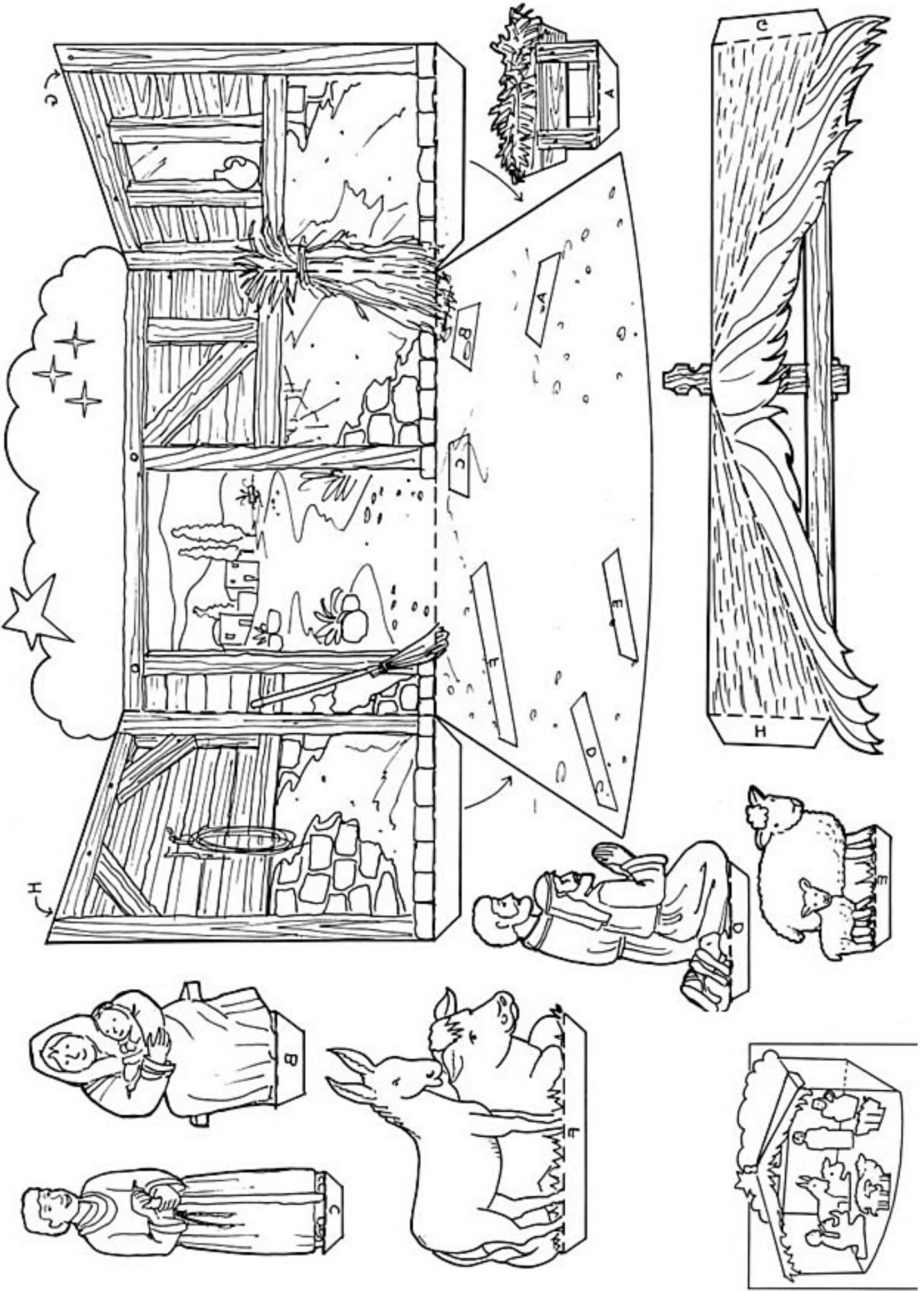


One of the Hmong children's favorite games is tire racing.

Who are the Hmong?

- **They are a people group.** They are a group of individuals, families, and clans who speak the same language, have the same culture, and believe the same beliefs.
- **They are an unreached people group.** They don't know Jesus, and there's no one around them to tell them about Jesus.
- **They have a Buddhist worldview.** It means they view the world in a Buddhist way.
 - Buddhists believe there are many paths to God.
 - **Pray** *that they will put their faith in Jesus, the only way that people can have a relationship with God.*
 - Some Buddhists believe that actions like repeating prayers help them earn merit, or good points, for their future life.
 - **Pray** *for them to hear that Jesus died on the cross to give them His free gift of salvation.*
 - Buddhists try to clear their minds of evil thoughts by meditation, yoga, and martial arts.
 - **Pray** *for them to understand that when Jesus comes into their hearts, God forgives and removes their sin.*
